



**Amplifire increased the pass rate on the National Restaurant Association ServSafe exam by 18% while reducing the failure rate by 34%.**

Every student in culinary arts must pass the National Restaurant Association’s ServSafe exam in order to begin a career in the restaurant business. Their coursework usually takes place at a community college, and includes topics like Sanitation and Safety.

Amplifire’s efficacy was tested at a large community college in North Carolina with an enrollment of more than 40,000 students. Amplifire was added to the curriculum in 2015. NRA ServSafe exam pass rates were then compared with those from the year before. Students who used Amplifire were 18% more likely to pass the exam—and 34% less likely to fail it.

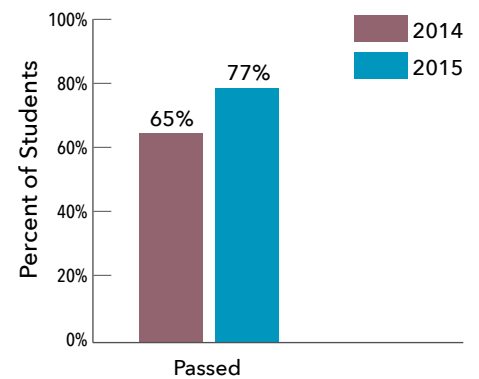
